

# Strawbs 'best yet'

THE late summer has produced the best ever crop of British strawberries, experts say.

The first harvest was three weeks behind — making the fruit extra juicy.

Andrew Seager, 64, who has grown strawberries for 50 years in Cheddar, Somerset, said: "They are the tastiest I have ever grown."

The British Summer Fruits body said this year's crop is 42 per cent sweeter and 15 per cent bigger than usual.
